## **Whitehills School Association Meeting Minutes**

January 10, 2017 • 7:00pm

- 1. Call to order, approval of agenda, circulate sign-in sheet
  - a. Moved; seconded, and approved.



- a. Today was the staff meeting rescheduled due to last week's snow day
  - i. New teachers' evaluation format was discussed, time frame was discussed, which resulted in some good discussion.
  - ii. We have not had outdoor recess in the last several days, which has caused students to be on edge so we are hoping that we will have recess soon.
  - iii. Swag tags
    - 1. These are military style tags that students will have an opportunity to earn in conjunction with the key goals the school has (i.e., be kind, be safe, be respectful).
      - a. They will be kept in the classroom and be worn on "Whitehills Wednesdays," a new opportunity for kids and staff to wear Whitehills gear or blue and try to build a family atmosphere.
  - iv. They talked about the Palooza and encouraged them to come
  - v. Parent asked about the early morning program with Mrs. V.
    - 1. It has been going well; about 12 kids are the average for each week but it does fluctuate.
  - vi. They are in the process of analyzing the students and the end date to assess is Friday and teachers are logging information into the system before Monday when it will be looked at school wide.
    - 1. February 15 there will be a write-up from this data which will be given to Dr. Thompson which will have pictures, attendance, and a lot of other data.
- 3. School Board Representative report from Nell Kuhnmuench
  - a. Five members of the "Girls in STEM" club started by Heather Mueller were invited by the Governor to the State of the State address, which is very exciting.
  - b. There is one more vote on February 6 for a \$93.77 million bond; millage increase would be 1.795. Bond vote is May 2.
    - 1. We will likely be looking to renew our sinking fund and combine them will an overall rate (she thinks that is what she is hearing).
    - 2. Estimation of completion would be fall of 2021, with each building taking 15-18 months.
    - 3. For each facility there will be lots of time spent on getting the staff and community to say what they want the buildings to look like. The buildings will also have about the same size and will not be "cookie cutter" buildings.
    - 4. Details like what school(s) will be done first is not known yet, but it is thought that since Donley is the largest elementary, it will be used as a swing school while construction is going on.



- 5. We voted in December because a group of professionals told us we would lose an entire construction season and the price would go up because of the time lapse.
  - a. The new board member did say she was uncomfortable with the January vote and she abstained but the other 6 board members all voted to pass it.
