  - a. Shane Johnson Principal
    - i. Mileage Club is back! Students are excited and weather has been good. Positive program for the students.

- v. Big Zoo Lesson. Jessica Eyde asked about Whitehills participation in program. Students go for the week and are assigned an animal to learn about it. It has been voluntary for teachers but gained traction over the years. The district is starting to see the value in the program. Generally, you have to pick you week early a year early. December was Whitehills week, and, due to COVID, the teachers declined to participate. The schools that are participating this year, they have teachers who have done it for several years, so they are trained in the program. Next year, the district is paying for the program but it will be optional based upon the teacher's preference as to whether they will participate.
