0 If the teachers can start talking about things on their wish list for next year, we would like to start budgeting and getting next year's budget drafted. This includes field trips; we would have liked to help fundraise for things like chartered buses for longer trips but we just need to know sooner to be able to help out.

- There is some confusion about where field trip "donations" go and how much the school district kicks in. The parent associations are just asked to do what they can do to help out, with no dollar amount given and no associations are giving the exact same amount. Maybe the school district could suggest a donation amount to the Parent Associations so that there is some sort of common suggestion.
E. Principal Report
o M-Step is underway and fifth grade took the language arts portion today. Third through fifth grade will experience M-Step.
- The average time was about 2 hours; one student did take until about $3: 00 \mathrm{pm}$. It is untimed with a break at lunchtime.
- This can create some stress for students and we are cognizant of that and giving extra recesses if necessary.
- Teachers do take time to help students understand that it is not just about what they get on their tests.
- Last year was very difficult, so teachers are adjusting things this year.
- An email blast was sent out before Spring Break but some parents mentioned not having heard of when the M-Step was going to start.
o Staffing came up today for how many classes there will be for each grade; it is a long process and will be gone over tomorrow. We will not enroll as many school of choice kids as last year so that we can ensure we have enough room. We are doing things now to get ready for next year, including an information sheet for parents to fill out for the teachers to have.
o Each building received $\$ 25,000$ from the district. But the funds cannot include personnel. We did start making a wish list that included furniture for the library and the book room.
o There were about 34 kids at Kindergarten Roundup, which includes a number of DK students.
