- Exhibits or models that give information (e.g. models or displays of the earth, the heart, an airplane, a ribosome, a tree, a bridge, etc.)
- Collections of items that you have described and classified (e.g. leaves, feathers, rocks, seashells, seeds, insects, etc.)

#### Rules for projects:

- Nothing dangerous (if you don't know if it's dangerous, ask a responsible adult).
- No live animals.
- If your project is messy, you are responsible for cleaning it up.
